

Specifying Sheave Sets

Four sheave sizes are available (see below). For most applications one sheave set is sufficient for the entire assortment of wire tensions. If you need to check tension in both 3/16" and 3/4" rope, then you should order two sheave sets. The operator must use the appropriate sheave set for the wire size and calibration stored. Changing sheave sets takes about two minutes using the included wrench.

CTM-SH-L Sheave for wires up to 1/4"
CTM-SH-P Sheave for wires up to 1/2"
CTM-SH-S Sheave for wires 1/4" to 3/4"
CTM-SH-T Sheave for wires 1/2" to 1"
