

Constant Load Weight



Constant Load Weight Installation:

- Loosen the set screw on the Constant Load Weight
- 2. Slide the Constant Load weight onto the lower barrel of the gauge
- Position the Constant Load Weight so that the ½" gauge foot
 protrudes approximately .002 .003" past the Constant Load Weight
 (the Constant Load Weight should be almost flush with the gauge foot)
- 4. Tighten the set screw on the Constant Load Weight

DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN SET SCREWS OR DAMAGE WILL OCCUR

Note: Increasing foot diameter can effect durometer readings. Rex Gauge Durometer Models 1500, H-1000, and 2100 are not recommended for use with constant load weights.
